Another man and myself traveled to NYC to put some new flooring in a missionary's home at the beginning of the year.

I have a group of three men going to Guyana, South America with me to do teacher training and evangelistic meetings the first week in April. It will be the first out of the country ministry for one full year. Please pray for easy passage both into and out of Guyana without delays and/or quarantine. The flights have been changed several times which complicates the timing of the covid testing required to enter both Guyana and the USA upon return.

This last month we have scheduled or re-scheduled several new or missed meetings from 2020 for this year. We are still waiting for countries to open up who are wanting us to come. Specifically the Philippines and Australia. This is certainly a big matter of prayer. Now that things are beginning to open up here in the States, we would be thrilled to come and do a teacher training refresher or VBS for your church. Give me a call and we can set something up.

While attending a funeral last month, I was approached by a young adult who asked me if I remembered him. I apologized that I didn't and he told me that he had been saved as a child at one of our camps. Although we don't always remember, I'm so glad that God does and grateful for how he crosses our paths with this kind of encouraging news! Thank you for your intersession and generous support. We are blessed!
